How do boards work?

Boards are a very simplified representation of kanban boards. They allow you to see tickets in columns where each column has a different status (state).

In pagure, each board is associated with a tag. Tagging a ticket will automatically make it show on the board in the default column (status) defined in the boards' settings. Similarly, un-tagging the ticket, will remove it from the board.

If a Status is set to "Close", then tickets reaching it will be closed and if a "Close status" is defined, tickets will be closed with that status.

Status set to "Close" tickets will only show 5 tickets by default, the small "eye" icon at the top will allow to toggle that setting and show all the tickets in that status if needed.

You can create as many boards as you want/need and you can de-activate boards that you no longer use. Boards that are de-activated will no longer show in the "Boards" drop-down in the menu. It is also not possible to add or remove tickets in a board that has been deactivated.

Access Levels

Ticket: A user or a group with this level of access can only edit metadata of an issue. This includes changing the status of an issue, adding/removing tags from them, adding/removing assignees and every other option which can be accessed when you click "Edit Metadata" button in an issue page. However, this user can not "create" a new tag or "delete" an existing tag because, that would involve access to settings page of the project which this user won't have. It also won't be able to "delete" the issue because, it falls outside of "Edit Metadata".

Collaborator: A user or a group with this level of access can do everything what a user/group with ticket access can do + it can commit to some branches in the project. These branches are defined here using their name or a pattern and needs to be comma separated.

Some examples:

- master,features/*
- el*
- master,f*

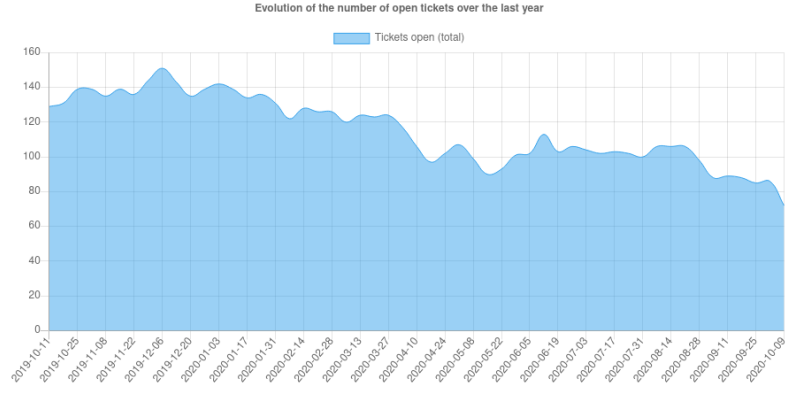
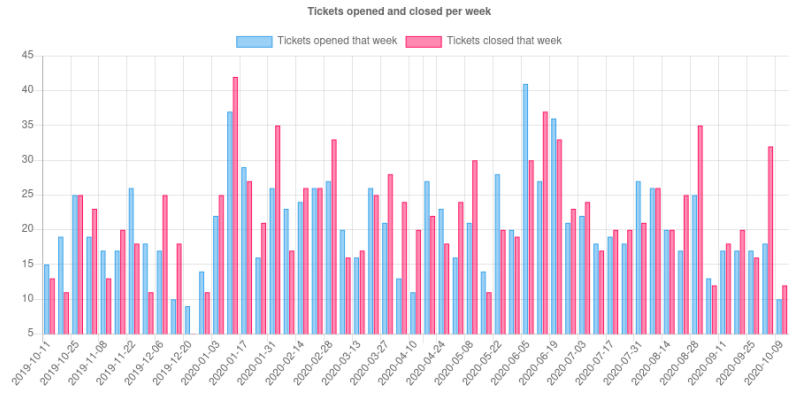

Others

- Ported the tests suite to run with pytest
- Now using whitenoise to serve theme static assets
- Default branch set upon creation

- Pagure is now easier than ever to deploy in containers/kubernetes
 - http push → no longer need for ssh
 - Whitenoise → pagure serves the static files directly now

- Retire gitolite backends
 - Make the “pagure” auth backend default
- Retire repoSpanner support
- Retire python2 support
- Retire fedmsg support

- Kerberos support for git push
- Kerberos support as an auth backend
